6. There are 32 legs in a room. If each table has 4 legs, how many tables are there?
7. 15 stars ★ are shared equally among 3 friends. How many stars does each friend get?
8. A shopkeeper has 50 ₹1 coins. He gives an equal amount to 5 people. How much does each get?
9. A string is 12 meters long. It is cut into 2 equal pieces. What is the length of each piece?
10. There are 21 days in 3 weeks. How many days are there in 1 week?

6. A car travels 81 km in 9 liters of petrol. How many km does it travel in 1 liter?
7. 96 notebooks are tied in bundles of 12. How many bundles are made?
8. A tailor uses 5 meters of cloth for one suit. How many suits can he make from 55 meters?
9. If 5 laddoos ● fit in a small box, how many boxes are needed for 75 laddoos?
10. There are 60 minutes in an hour. How many hours are there in 120 minutes?

4. If 8 buses carry 400 people, how many people are in each bus if they are seated equally?
5. A group of friends won ₹960 in a competition. If they are 8 friends, how much does each get?
6. A box of 120 chocolates is shared among 10 kids. How many more does a kid get than if there were 12 kids?
7. 150 seeds are sown in 5 plots. How many seeds are in each plot?
8. A worker earns ₹840 in a week (7 days). What is his daily wage?
9. There are 132 students going on a trip. If one van carries 11 students, how many vans are needed?
10. Challenge: Divide 100 into 4 parts. Then divide each part by 5. What is the final number?
