3. Priya bought a notebook for ₹45 and a pencil for ₹10. How much total money did she spend?
4. There are 24 birds sitting on a tree. 9 birds fly away. How many birds are still on the tree?
5. Anish has 3 packs of crayons. Each pack has 10 crayons. How many crayons are there in total?
6. A gardener planted 32 rose plants ✿ and 18 sunflower plants ✨. How many plants are there altogether?
7. If one chocolate costs ₹5, what is the total cost of 8 chocolates?
8. Sita had ₹100. She bought a toy for ₹60. How much money is left with her?
9. A school bus has 40 seats. If 28 children are sitting, how many seats are empty?
10. Count the stars ★: 12 stars in one row and 15 in another. Total stars: _____

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Level: Intermediate

1. A farmer has 5 cows. Each cow gives 8 liters of milk daily. How much milk is collected in total?
2. Kavita bought 4 mangoes for ₹20 each. She gave a ₹100 note to the shopkeeper. How much change will she get?
3. There are 120 pages in a book. Amit read 45 pages on Monday and 30 pages on Tuesday. How many pages are left?
4. A cricket team scored 145 runs in the first innings and 160 runs in the second. What is the total score?
5. There are 6 rows of chairs in a hall. Each row has 15 chairs. How many people can sit in the hall?
6. A toy car costs ₹85. If Rohan buys 2 cars, how much does he need to pay?
7. A box contains 60 pens. If they are shared equally among 5 students, how many pens does each student get?
8. Mother made 48 laddoos ●. She put them in boxes of 6 laddoos each. How many boxes did she use?
9. A train has 8 coaches. If each coach has 70 seats, what is the total seating capacity of the train?
10. A kite seller had 200 kites. He sold 125 on Saturday and 40 on Sunday. How many kites are left?

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Level: Advanced

1. A shopkeeper bought 15 dozen bananas. If 10 bananas were rotten, how many good bananas does he have?
2. If 4 notebooks cost ₹120, find the cost of 1 notebook and then find the cost of 7 such notebooks.
3. A school library has 450 books. If 125 are stories, 150 are science, and the rest are maths, how many maths books are there?
4. Rahul travels 15 km by bus and 3 km by walking every day. How much distance does he cover in 5 days?
5. Divide ₹500 among 4 brothers equally. How much will each brother get?
6. A water tank can hold 500 liters. It currently has 235 liters. How much more water is needed to fill it?
7. Challenge: If 2 oranges cost ₹30, how much will 10 oranges cost?
8. A box of 24 apples costs ₹480. What is the price of one apple?
9. Suresh saves ₹25 every day. How much money will he save in the month of February (28 days)?
10. A rectangular park is 20m long and 15m wide. What is the total distance covered if you walk around it once?
